

We as Christians are living a life that is often described as "walking with God." I like that image! It is at once a tremendous privilege and a significant challenge. You read the Bible and it seems a bit distant from the challenges you are facing. At times you wonder if your faith is really connected to your everyday life and struggle. Personally, I like the time of blessing much more than the stretching. It seems the stretching comes on before you know you are in it. It happens! Not so with the times of blessing. Well, I've heard it said that "Coincidence is just God's way of getting things done without calling undue attention to Himself."

I wonder just what God is doing in your life that you have failed to recognize as an answer to long standing prayers. Now is the time to stop and take account of the things that God is doing all around us and in us. It is time to thank the Lord and rejoice.

Yes, times can be tough, but right in the middle of our difficulty God is doing things we have desired for years. Praise the Lord! "Let everything that has breath praise the Lord!"

Help for Memorizing Scripture

- 1. Write the verse and reference on an index card.
- 2. Read the verse in its context and try to understand what it means.
- 3. Read the verse aloud several times.
- 4. Divide the verse into short and meaningful phrases. Learn to quote the first phrase and then build on it. Continue until you are able to quote the entire verse.
- 5. Repeat the verse to another person and ask him/her to check your accuracy.
- 6. Review the memorized verse regularly using the card you made in step #1. Do it daily for the first six weeks, then weekly for the next six weeks, and monthly after than.
